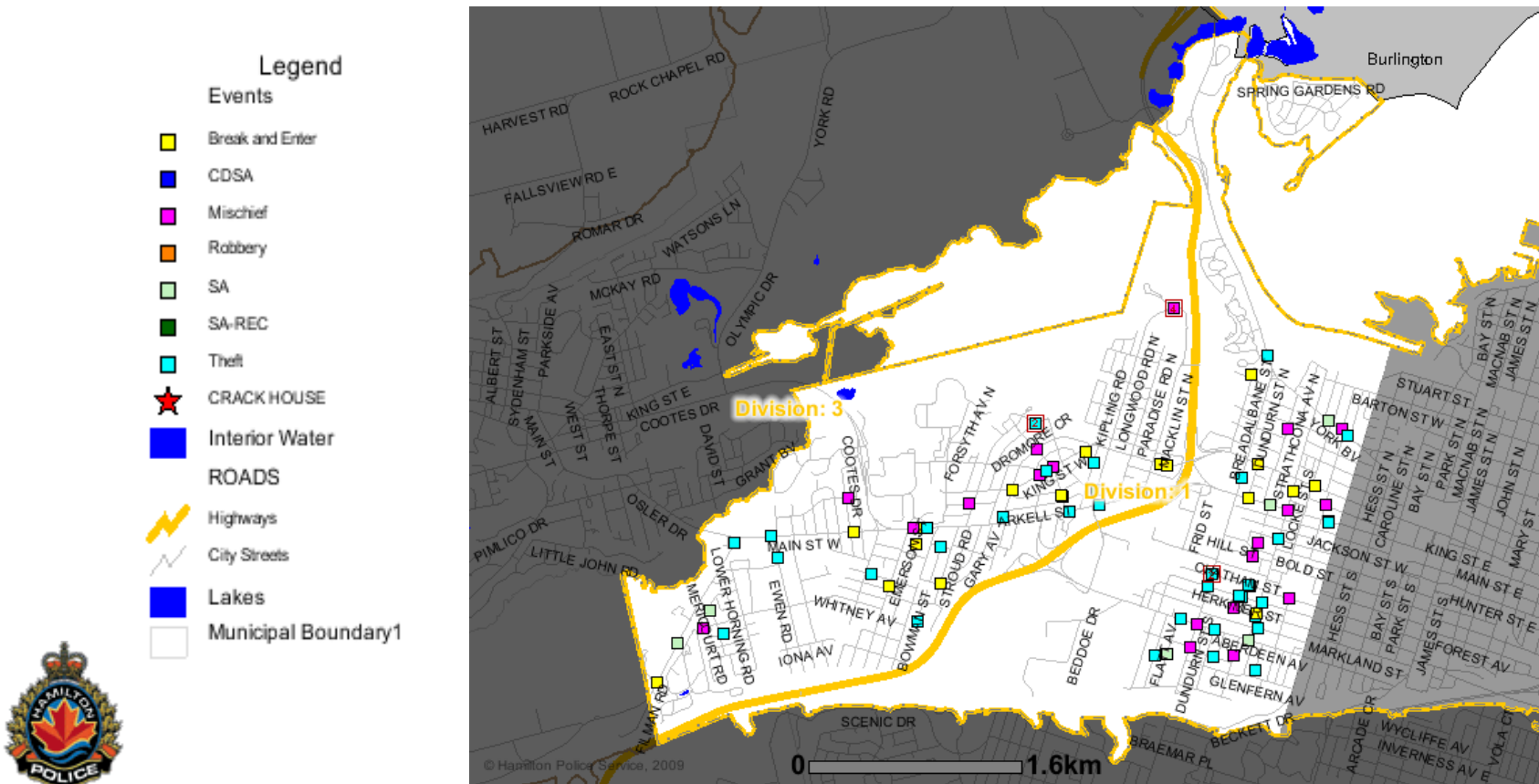


WEST TOWN CRIME STATS July 2009

I can share with you several people have been arrested and that Break & Enters have decreased by 30 % from June. Stolen Auto's have decreased by 53%. Theft from auto has increased by 53%.

The items taken from autos still cause me alarm; Cash, iPod's, computers, GPS', and cameras. Please remove items from your vehicle before entering your residence.
