Break and Enters (B &E's)

Remember to advise your neighbours when you will be away and have someone take in your mail and newspapers (better yet, cancel your paper until your return). Keep a porch light on.

Notes from the Crime Manager:

The month of June saw a reduction in Break and Enters, and Theft from Autos.

Theft from autos continues to be the number one crime in Division One. I cannot stress enough, the need to ensure that no valuables are left in your vehicle while it is unattended. Although we have seen a small decrease from last month, we must still be vigilant in reporting all entries regardless if you intend to go through your insurance or not. The only way to compile statistics and possible suspects is with your assistance. (Strathcona, that means you!!!)

A suspect was arrested in the last week of June. He had been very active in the Durand and Kirkendall neighbourhoods. The Service will be able to clear approximately 100 entries to this one individual. To date we have been able to identify a dozen different groups committing entries to vehicles in Division One.

Some suspects to watch for in West Town are:

- A male and female team have been seen panhandling in front of the beer store and LCBO on Dundurn St S. They are also suspects in thefts from autos. Both have a heavy crack addiction. Male suspect described as 32 yrs of age, 5'10", scruffy looking, brown straight hair, receding hairline, full beard, thin build. The male suspect was last seen wearing blue jeans, light blue top, with a dark coloured backpack and dark coloured baseball cap. Female suspect - white, 29 years of age, thin build, 5'9", 130 lbs, brown hair (often dyes hair) light complexion, last seen wearing a pink top, pink tartan patterned pants, white socks and black shoes. Both suspects are of No Fixed Address (NFA). Because they are NFA they may wear the same cloths for days in a row.
- There is also another team of young people in the Kirkendall neighbourhood area: 2 White males, approx 17 years old and a female 15/16 years old. Thin build, blond hair, approximately 5' 6"/7", 120 lbs. Police have little information on these youths but believe the female may have other "girlfriends" involved. Any and all information as to the identity of these youths would be greatly appreciated.

Uniform and plain cloths officers will continue to monitor the parks and do periodic sweeps for the remainder of the season. If you see young persons carrying alcohol heading for any one of our parks, please call police. Recently, the Crime managers arrested and confiscated alcohol from youths in Highland Park.

Noise complaints continue to be an issue in Westdale. It has come to my attention that although complainants are calling in while the offence is in progress, the call takers are holding the call. By the time the police arrive, the party has ended (but not always). It has been requested that the radio room not hold the call and dispatch as quickly as possible. Unfortunately, noise complaints, regardless if they are in progress are not are very high on the priority list. All officers have been made aware of the By-law short wordings in order to fine residents who are in non-compliance. It has been requested that a zero tolerance be given to repeat offenders.

I appreciate the frustration some residence have been experiencing and ask for your patience and request you continue to call the non-emergent number when your lawful enjoyment of your property has been violated.
